Calgel Teething Gel

Uses

To relieve teething pain and soothe infants' gums where nonpharmacological treatments have failed to provide sufficient relief. The gel also has mild antiseptic properties.

Dosage

Babies from the age of five months: rub a pea-sized blob of gel to a clean finger tip and spread gently onto the sore area of gum. The dose may be repeated if necessary after 3 hours, up to a maximum of 6 doses in 24 hours. For short term use of no more than 7 days.

Sugar-free teething gel containing: Lidocaine Hydrochloride 0.33% w/w, Cetylpyridinium Chloride 0.1% w/w,
